ITINERARY:

We will meet in Cabo San Lucas, then board the 116' Nautilus Gallant Lady the late afternoon of June 24. We'll head into the Sea of Cortez, as far north as the islands near La Paz. The plan is to look for schooling mobula rays and the orcas that follow these schools. A few trips have also been able to dive with Sperm Whales, Pilot Whales, Blue Whales and other pelagics.

Nautilus Liveboards now owns a spotter plane that will help find these pelagics from the air. The 2022 season was very productive with locating the large schools of mobulas and orcas. This will be a combined free diving and scuba diving trip. It's best to free dive with the pelagics, however we will also have the opportunity to scuba dive on the various reefs and seamounts.
